

Privacy Policy

When you visit www.soproac.com (the "Website"), SoPro AC, a non-profit corporation ("SoPro") does not collect any personally identifiable information about you unless you specifically provide it to SoPro. Except as required by law, or expressly authorized by SoPro, SoPro will not provide any personally identifiable information regarding you to any third parties. Any personally identifiable information that you submit to SoPro will be used solely for the purpose of responding to inquiries or requests made by you.

Your visit to the Website is tracked through a standard web traffic statistics program, which retains records of traffic on the Website, as well as numerical counts of visitors by domain, Uniform Resource Locator, search engine, keywords used, and other standard web measurements.

SoPro uses cookies to help recognize that a device has visited the Website previously. SoPro does not use cookies to identify individuals. SoPro uses cookies to improve your experience when you visit the Website. A "cookie" is a small data file that is downloaded to a device when a user accesses certain websites. Visitors that do not want cookies placed on their computers may set their browser to refuse and/or disable cookies. The steps to refuse and/or disable cookies varies depending on the browser used, but the steps may generally be found by using the "Help" feature available in your Internet browser.

If you choose to register to receive e-mail correspondences from SoPro, you need to furnish SoPro with certain required information, including your name, e-mail address and the name of your company. The contact information you provide to SoPro is stored in a database that is not located on the Internet. The materials you request will be transmitted to you via e-mail. Please include your name and your e-mail address in the body of the e-mail correspondence. SoPro will make a reasonable effort to respond to your request in a timely manner.

SoPro is committed to complying with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA). The Website and services are not directed to children under thirteen (13) years of age. SoPro does not knowingly collect personal information from children under thirteen (13) years of age. If SoPro receives personal information that it discovers was provided by a child under thirteen (13) years of age, SoPro will promptly destroy such information.
